I - The financing challenge

- To make appropriate forms of funding readily available to support key actors and accelerate the innovation cycle, <u>especially for SMEs</u>.
- Several Member States have launched <u>national initiatives</u> and partnerships to stimulate water sector innovation (e.g. France, Netherlands, UK, Spain, Portugal)
- Action is needed to stimulate both the demand and supply of innovative solutions in a <u>collaborative framework</u> between Academia, SME's and Large Water Enterprises to addressing our most urgent environmental challenges.

II - SIP's envisaged priorities

SIP proposes a limited number of strategic priorities and possible actions to improve financing for innovation in the water sector, through an appropriate blending of <u>financial</u> and <u>non-financial</u> instruments. The <u>3 main priorities</u> (from a impact, urgency and likelihood of quick success standpoint) seem to be:

- 1. Improve access to <u>finance for SMEs</u> (especially those with potentially disruptive technologies).
- Incentivize <u>public sector innovation</u>, notably in public procurement, support to the pre-commercial phase of new technologies
- 3. Develop financial support mechanisms and <u>reduce excess of bureaucracy</u> within the EU for innovative EU companies in water-related export markets.

II - SIP's envisaged priorities

- 1. Improve access to finance for SMEs (especially those with potentially disruptive technologies)
 - ✓ Challenges / Key issues
 - Barriers for innovation and bottlenecks
 - Market opportunities
 - Possible actions:
 - A detailed sector review of EU national and international experiences with VC and other financing and non-financial mechanisms;
 - Develop a platform for information on access to finance;
 - Create a European vehicle to mix private and public funds for long term venture-capital in water;
 - Set up a Public-Private Investment Financing Facility;
 - Promote PPPs;



II - SIP's envisaged priorities

- 2. Incentivize <u>public sector innovation</u>, notably in public procurement, support to the pre-commercial phase of new technologies
 - Challenges / Key issues
 - Barriers for innovation and bottlenecks
 - ✓ Market opportunities
 - ✓ Possible actions:
 - Financial incentives to public authorities adopting innovative approaches to services and asset procurement;
 - Develop public innovation budget lines at the EU level but also at regional/city clusters level;
 - Technical assistance to public authorities to prepare tender dossiers and evaluate bids;
 - Increase knowledge sharing on technologies, costs and outcomes.

II - SIP's envisaged priorities

- 3. Develop <u>financial support mechanisms</u> and reduce <u>excess of bureaucracy</u> within the EU for innovative EU companies in water-related export markets.
 - Challenges / Key issues
 - Barriers for innovation and bottlenecks
 - Market opportunities
 - ✓ Possible actions:
 - Review of existing financial support mechanisms to support EU and non-EU water companies operating in export markets;
 - Develop dissemination strategies through regional/national/EU networks;
