

For Investors






- \$15B (28%) of IFC co-financing


... and \$ 4 500 B of public procurement in developing countries (15% of GDP)

The World Bank is a « procurement business facilitator »...

- Regular flow of 100,000 WB financed contracts worth \$25 billion per year in all categories (CW,G,C), sectors (Hard to soft) and size(from \$10 000 to \$600M),
- 10,000 contracts prior reviewed (10%) worth \$12.7 billion (50%),
- 77 % contracts are ICB, 10 % contracts are NCB,
- 70 % of contracts awarded to local companies,
- « Best practice » projects
- 220 WB staff involved in procurement, the Bank is a referee for companies who are **sure to get paid**,
- The large majority of bidders are SME's.





 In 2011, Water Portfolio amounts to \$7.2B in lending commitments




IBRD and IDA Lending by Sector | Fiscal 2012

Share of total lending of \$35.3 Billion




Water, Sanitation, and Flood Protection IBRD and IDA Lending by Region | Fiscal 2012


Share of total lending of \$3.6 billion




Water Portfolio by Region FY 2006-2011




Water Portfolio by Sub Sector FY 2006-2011


