Definición de WOP:

partenariados sin ánimo de lucro entre dos o más operadores de agua y/o saneamiento con el objetivo de fortalecer sus capacidades para la provisión sostenible de servicios de calidad para todos.

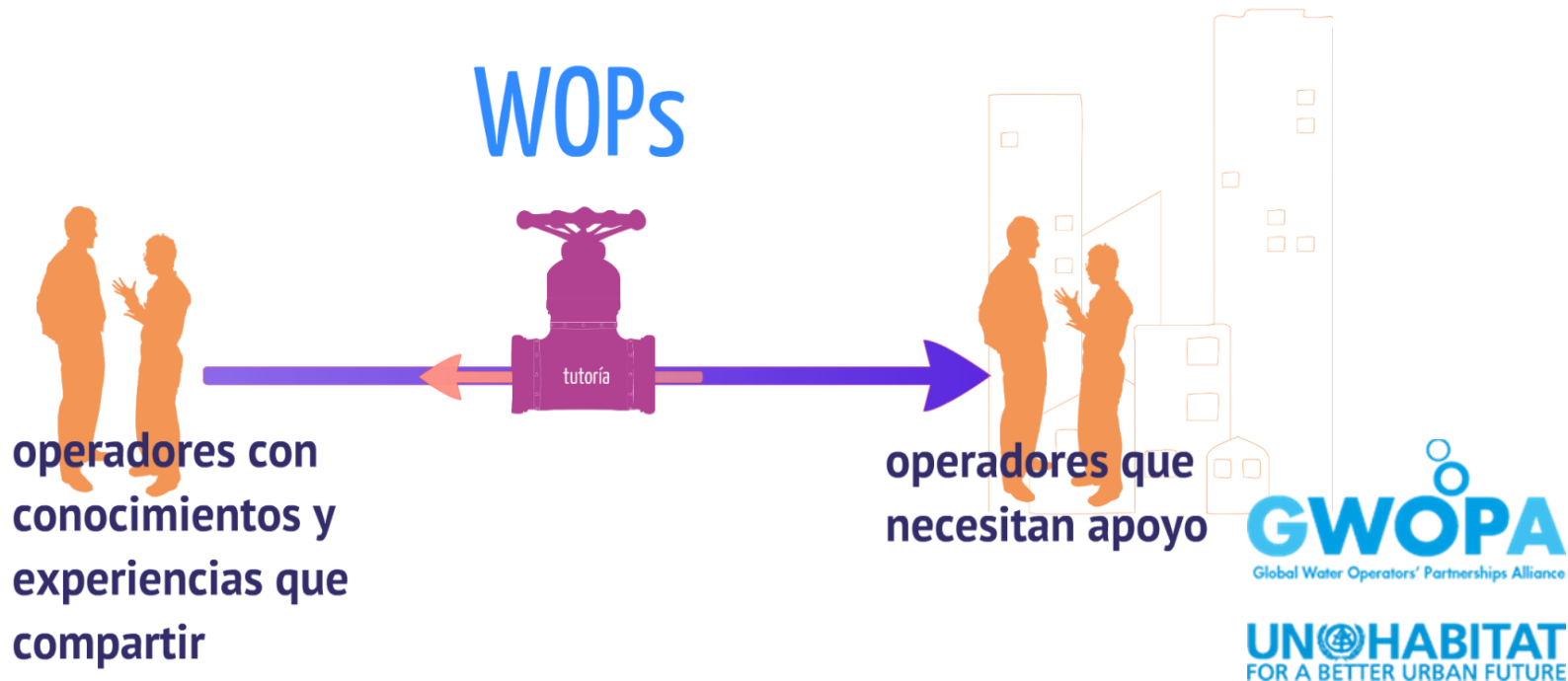

WOPs: peer-to-peer capacity building exchanges for watsan operators, twining

Principles: mutual benefit, inclusive and not-for-profit. Mentor/mentee. South/South or North/South

Adapted to the needs of the operators, can vary in scope (specific on one technical theme, or a combination several, PIP/ short term to medium term)
