- Portugal as case study:
  - Notable water reform in Portugal (1993-2015).
  - A strong regulator (ERSAR) was created (2000).
  - Mobilized large investments (10 000 M €) on water services in the last 25 years.
  - Planned to invest more 3 700 M€ until 2020.
  - Spend 2 000 M€ annually with management. operation & maintenance of the services.
  - Currently has valuable public infrastructure assets,.
  - Many successes have been achieved but also some mistakes was made.

  - Legislative framework.
  - Institutional framework.
  - Governance models.
  - Service access targets.
  - Quality of service goals.
  - Tariff policy.
  - Tax policy.






